- 2. Candidates who wish to apply for more than one post will be required to submit separate online applications alongwith separate application processing fees. Candidates need to send hard copy (printout) of Online Application Form along with all self-attested copies of certificates/ educational qualification/ experience/testimonials application fee and other requisite documents in support of eligibility in the manner described in above SI. No. 1.
- **3.** The Candidate are required to upload all the necessary documents, certificates in the online application, incomplete application from in any respect shall not be considered.
- 4. No TA/DA shall be paid to the Candidate for attending the Written Test/ Interview.
- 5. Mere fulfilling of minimum qualification does not entitle a candidate to be called for or written test/ Interview.
- 6. Screening Committee shall device its own criteria to scrutinize the applications to restrict the number of candidate to be called for Interview.
- 7. Fee once paid is not refundable under any circumstances except in case of clause 29 (iv) of the advertisement.
- Applicants are advised to submit the applications to the University well in advance without waiting for the last date to avoid postal delay or any delay due to other unforeseen events or circumstances. The University shall not be responsible for any postal delay at any stage.
- 9. The reservations / relaxations policy for SC / ST / OBC / PwBD / EWS Candidates will be provided as per the existing Govt. of India / UGC policy. The employees of Central Govt. /State Govt./ Universities/ shall be granted as per the rule of Govt. of India. Candidate applying against the unreserved vacancy cannot be considered for any relaxation.

- 10. Reservations for SC, ST, OBC, EWS and Persons with Benchmark Disabilities will be as per existing Government of India norms as amended from time to time. Candidates applying for the reserved posts should clearly state to which category they belong.

In case of candidates want to claim benefits under the Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) category, the candidates' relevant disability should not be less than 40%. Proof to this effect, must be enclosed with the application as per Annexure - IV-I, IV-II, IV-III (which ever applicable) without which the application will be treated as 'General (unreserved)'.

- 12. Person who is serving in Govt./ Semi Govt./ PSUs/Autonomous bodies should apply through proper channel along with vigilance clearance certificate from the competent authority. However, he may send an advance copy of his application and in case his application is not forwarded due to whatever reasons till the time of written test or interview as the case may be, he/she, should produce a "No Objection Certificate along with the Vigilance clearance certificate in a sealed cover" from the employer failing which he shall not be allowed to appear in the test / interview as the case may be.
- 13. The University will not be responsible for any loss of e-mail, loss of any communication due to wrong address provided by the candidates.
- 14. Hall Tickets / Call letters and other correspondence for attending the Examination / Interview, etc., will be sent only to the eligible candidates by email only.
- 15. The application for appointment on deputation shall be forwarded by the employer along with the Annual Performance Appraisal Reports (APARs)/ACR for the preceding five years and Vigilance Clearance Certificate, duly certified by the Competent Authority.
- 16. Terms and conditions of deputation will be regulated in accordance with the department of Personnel & Training O.M. No.6/8/2009-Estt(Pay) dated 17th June 2010 and O.M. No.2/6/2016-Estt (Pay-II) dated 17.02.2016, as amended from time to time. A person in higher Grade Pay shall not be eligible for appointment to a post carrying a lower Grade Pay.
- 17. The scale/pay grade/level of regular post would only be taken into account for deciding the eligibility for appointment/selection to a higher post on deputation basis. Pay Scale and Grade Pay received on Financial up-gradation under MACP will not be considered for deputation.

- 18. It shall be the responsibility of the candidate to assess his/her own eligibility for the post for which he/she is applying in accordance with the prescribed qualifications, experience, etc., and submit his application duly filled-in, along with the desired information and documents as per the advertisement. Suppression of factual information, supply of fake documents, providing false or misleading information or canvassing in any manner on the part of the candidates shall lead to his disqualification. In case, it is detected at any point of time in future, even after appointment, that the candidate was not eligible, his appointment shall be liable to be terminated forthwith as per this clause. This must be mentioned in the letter of offer and appointment clearly. In case of any ambiguity in the recruitment rules in general and eligibility in particular for any post, the decision of the Executive Council shall be final.
- 19. Acceptance of documents submitted by an applicant shall be subject to verification by the competent authority at any point of time even after joining the employment. If any document is found to be false / fake / incorrect either before or after appointment, the document shall be summarily rejected or action may be initiated against the candidate which shall lead to cancellation of his appointment, as the case may be.
- 20. The person appointed against any post shall be governed by the Act/ Statutes/ Ordinances/ Rules of the University and also the CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964, CCS (CCA) Rule,1965 or any other rules of the Government of India, as amended from time to time and any other rule/ resolution prescribed specifically for maintaining the conduct of the employees by the Executive Council of the University.
- 21. The appointment of a candidate shall be subject to verification of character and antecedents by the competent authority. Until the verification of character and antecedents reports are received, the appointment shall be treated as provisional. In case the report/s with regard to his conduct, character, antecedents, etc., is found to be unsatisfactory, the appointment shall be cancelled / terminated forthwith.
- 22. Canvassing in any form on behalf of any candidate shall be treated as a disqualification which shall lead to cancellation of candidature.
- 23. The selected candidate shall produce a certificate from the Medical Board issued by a Govt. Hospital / or Govt./CGHS empanelled Hospital for Group A post as the case may be prior to his joining. In cases where a person has already been examined by a Medical Board in respect of his previous appointment and if standard of medical examination prescribed for the new post is the same, then he need not be required to undergo a fresh examination. For this purpose, he has to submit a copy of the medical certificate duly countersigned by the designated officer of the University.
- 24. The terms and conditions of appointment shall be communicated to the candidate in the form of 'Offer of Appointment' to the selected candidates. If the candidate does not accept the terms and conditions mentioned in the offer of appointment within the stipulated time, the offer shall be treated as withdrawn.
- 25. The selected candidates shall be required to perform duties as per the Rules of the University, as amended from time to time. The University shall be free to assign any duty as per the exigency of the situation at any time even during non-working hours / holidays which the employee shall have to perform without fail to avoid any disciplinary action.
- 26. The selected candidate shall be governed by the Pension Scheme/ New Pension Scheme of the Govt. of India, as the case may be, duly extended by UGC.
- 27. The selected candidate shall be liable to serve anywhere within the jurisdiction of the University.
- 28. At the time of recruitment, a 'Service Agreement' shall be executed between the University and the employee concerned and a copy of the same shall be kept with the Registrar. Such service agreement shall be duly stamped as per the rates applicable.
- 29. The candidate shall bring all original certificates relating to his age, qualifications, experience, etc. at the time of tests or interview wherever applicable. In case the candidate fails to submit the original documents for verification of the certified photocopies of the enclosures to his application, he may not be allowed to appear at the tests/interview and his candidature may be treated as cancelled without any further communication in this regard.

- (i) The details of the vacancies shall be mentioned in the advertisement. The University may also include the details with regard to anticipated vacancies arising due to retirement of employee/s of that particular year which shall be filled through the instant advertisement. The University reserves the right to fill or not to fill up the posts advertised for any reasons whatsoever. However, the number of posts filled up shall not exceed the number of posts advertised including anticipated vacancies.
- (ii) The University may draw a panel in the form of a waiting list to fill up a post. In case a candidate on higher merit regrets to join within a period of one year or resigns/dies after joining, within a period of one year, the offer shall be made to the next candidate on the merit, if otherwise in order, to reduce the delay in filling up of the vacancies. Such a vacancy should not be treated as fresh vacancy.
- (iii) The University reserves the right to withdraw an advertisement, either partly or wholly, at any time without assigning any reason.
