6. The engagement services of a Coach shall be liable to termination at any time by notice in writing given either by the coach to the institute, or by the institute to the coach. The period of such notice shall be fifteen (15) days, unless otherwise agreed to by the institute and the coach
7. The Part-Time Sports Coach can be engaged for a period of **08 months in an Academic Year**, comprising:
 - 04 months during the odd Semester
 - 04 months during the Even Semester
8. The other terms and conditions of service of coach shall be such as may be specified by the institute in the letter of engagement.
9. All the selections shall be made through the recommendations of the Selection Committee based on performance in walk in interview which is intended to test various aspects of personality quotient, domain knowledge and suitability of the candidates for ready development for job/assignment with relevant experience etc.
10. Institute will not entertain any request for change of date of walk-in-interview by the individual candidates under any circumstances.
11. The candidates should keep a regular watch for the related information on recruitment process available on the Institute website only.

Other terms and conditions:
